Keys To Effective Praying

Specific Information

- Can be shared in an all day Saturday (9:00 AM - 4:30 PM with 45 minute break for lunch), weekend (varied times), or Sunday through Wednesday evening format
- Evening services should be structured for one 45 minute message
- Requires the use of participant workbooks, overhead projector, and auditorium sized screen
- Recommended to be preceded by Prayer For Spiritual Awakening series

Message Description

Sunday Morning Worship: *Prayer: The Misplaced Ministry In The Church*

This expository message from 1 Timothy 2:1-8 Biblically establishes prayer as the foundational ministry within the church. The message reveals the four types of praying that comprise the full prayer program within the local church.

Sunday Evening: *Keys To Effective Personal Praying*

With a focus on the private prayer life of the individual in a local church, this message from the familiar prayer passage of Matthew 7:7-8 helps the believer detect the difference in the daily, difficult, and desperate demands in his prayer life. He will learn the various conditions that equip him for each demand.

Monday Evening: *Keys To Effective Partnership Praying*

With a focus on companionship praying, this session provides insights needed to choose a proper prayer partner from Jesus' teaching in Luke 18. The session concludes with a challenge from 1 Peter 3 for husbands to choose their wives as their most important prayer partner.

Tuesday Evening: *Keys To Effective Public Praying Part One*

With a focus on small group and corporate praying, this session is based on the prayer life of the early church as recorded in the book of Acts. Valuable prayer principles concerning the leadership and organization of the prayer group as well as the verbalization of the prayers is gained from the experiences of these early believers.

Wednesday Evening: *Keys To Effective Public Praying Part Two*

Continuing with a focus on small group and corporate praying, this session includes an overview of corporate prayer meetings throughout the Bible. An emphasis is given to the mobilization and the realization of corporate prayer and small group prayer meetings throughout the local church. The meeting culminates with a challenge from Zechariah 8.
